Agency Role.

The primary mission of AEMA is to prepare for, plan, organize, and coordinate emergency activities.

Responsibilities.

- AEMA is responsible for the administration of Alabama's emergency programs. AEMA coordinates mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery of state entities in cooperation with federal and local governments.

Capabilities and Abilities.

- When necessary provide 24 hour manning of the State Emergency Operations Center
- Various communications capabilities
- Mobile Command Post
- Automated tracking of resource requests and message traffic
- Primary State EBS notification point
