



ResponseLINK

ResponseLINK is a web-based emergency response communications system. This system is a valuable tool to keep emergency response personnel informed of an incident's status and updates. In ResponseLINK, a user may view NOAA incident specific information (reports, photos, maps, etc.) and National Response Center Incident Notifications.

Who may have access to ResponseLINK?

Any federal, state, or local agency emergency responder, and members or alternate members of Regional Response Teams.



Where can the public go to view spill information?

ResponseLINK is not a public site and therefore any information contained on the site may not be distributed to the public. Presently NOAA is upgrading the public site www.incidentnews.gov.

How do I report a problem I am having with ResponseLINK?

How do I obtain access to ResponseLINK?
