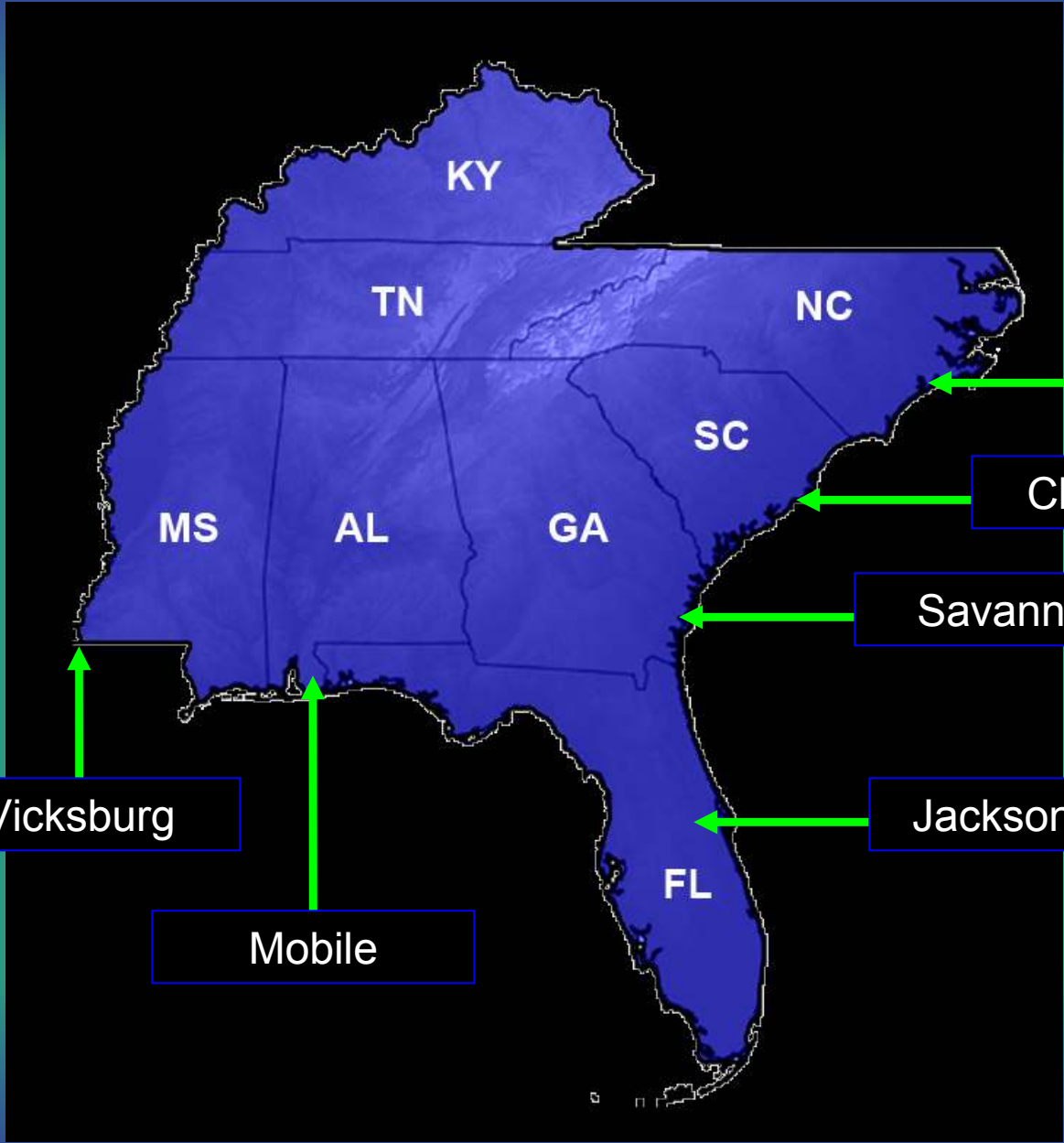


Value of Partnering with the U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

- **Easy access to regulatory personnel when Section 404 or Section 10 issues surface (removal of beached vessels during Katrina disaster).**
- **Close working relationship with all resource agencies so that sound, beneficial environmental decisions are made during the permit process (general permit for vessel removal).**
- **Regulatory contacts are located within the district where the disaster occurs; they are familiar with the area and its special resources.**
