

# **SONS 2007 Lessons Learned**



- **Establish a Functional Response Structure**
  - **How does the Regional Emergency Operations Center, MAC, Area Command and the Incident Management Teams interrelate in the response.**
  - **Who is in charge of establishing objectives, resource ordering, reporting of data, and informing key programs within the agency and outside partners.**

# **SONS 2007 Lessons Learned**



- **Information Management**
  - **Have plenty of GIS and database management personnel on site**
  - **Have as much information preplanned in GIS format (satellite imagery, RMP and Tier 2 facilities,**
  - **Establish a way of managing data and reporting within and outside the Agency (WEBEOC, Databases, Situation Reports)**

# SONS 2007 Lessons Learned



- **Ordering of Resources**
  - **You need staff not only trained in ICS Logistics but has the experience and authority to order resources.**
  - **Who is in charge of determining the sharing of resources, especially if the event involves multiple regions.**
  - **Who makes the prioritization of resources? EPA HQs, the MAC, Area Command or the individual Regions?**
  - **When ordering resources always check with State and Local agencies on their capabilities and available resources.**
