**Step 1: Define Action Area**

**Step 3: Conduct Record Review for Previous Consultations**

Review unit Administrative Record, Area Contingency Plan, and applicable Geographic Response Strategies to determine if consultation activities were previously conducted in the Action Area.

- o IF NO, proceed to Step 4.
- o IF YES, does the existing consultation cover the same Action Area, Response Actions, species, and time of year (for seasonal occurrence)?
  - o YES: No further action necessary. Implement Best Management Practices and Conservation Measures as determined in previous consultation.

**NO:** Proceed to Step 4 to engage in technical assistance conversations on those Response Actions, species, and/or seasonal occurrence of species within the Action Area different from previous consultation.
