GOETHALS OIL SPILL

SITUATION/IMPACT

28MAR19: USCG/NJ DEP/NY DEC RESPONDED TO A DISCHARGE OF HEAVY FUEL OIL. INITIAL REPORT WAS A POTENTIAL DISCHARGE OF APPROXIMATELY 371,154 GALLONS

- > RP'S: AMOTOSA VERMIETUNGSGESELLSCHAFT
- > MEDIA & POLITICAL POTENTIAL: LOW
- > ACTUAL TOTAL DISCHARGE: UNKNOWN (10,000 GALLON POTENTIAL)
- > VESSELS & FACILITIES IMPACTED: GLOBAL NYCT, M/V DUBLIN EXPRESS
- CAUSE OF DISCHARGE WAS DETERMINED TO BE A HULL PUNCTURE DIRECTLY BENEATH THE VESSELS FUEL TANK.
- THE DAMAGE WAS CAUSED BY THE VESSEL LOSING MULTIPLE CONTAINERS AND STRIKING ONE DURING HEAVY WEATHER.
- THE 16" GASH WAS DISCOVED BENEATH THE VESSELS FUEL TANK (7 FEET BELOW THE WATER LINE).

FUTURE ACTIONS

- > CLEANUP EFFORTS ONGOING
- > ENFORCEMENT PENDING



- > ESTIMATED OF OVERALL CG EXPENDITURES: \$417,537.25
- >OSLTF: \$80,000 (Direct Cost \$73,054.00)
- ➤ CG SUPPORT: CG-IC, LSC, SITL, LOFR, CG- DIV/GRP SUP, 5
 ATLANTIC STRIKE TEAM MEMBERS, USCG DISTRICT 1 PIAT,
 SCAT
- > TOTAL PEOPLE ON SCENE: 10 DAILY (CMD POST: 7; FIELD: 3)
- > DAY OF RESPONSE: 26 DAYS
- ► HOURS OF WORK COMPLETED: APPROXIMATELY 800+ HRS
- ➤ OIL RECOVERED TO DATE: ≈ 35,000 GALLONS OILY WATER


