






Location



Exercise Scenario

- In the early morning hrs of Sept 12, 2019 the Maersk M/V transiting northbound approximately 20 nm offshore reported that they had struck an unknown object resulting in an significant discharge.
- Trajectory and satellite imaging had a large unknown mass of oil heading North-North West towards Parramore Island and Cedar Island.
- An Incident Command Post was Established at Eastern Shore Community College and booming operations were staged at VIMS, in Wachapreague, VA.











Eastern Shore Annex (2019)

- This annex identifies key Points of Contact (POC), command posts, response resources, seasonality concerns, and information key to mitigate environmental, wildlife, and community impacts.






Geographical Response Strategies











Lessons Learned - Best Practice

- Interagency Cooperation
 - Great teamwork & coordination between multiple agencies & organizations
 - Established working relationships between stakeholders and port partners
- Pre-Exercise coordination with community and other agencies
 - Exercise enforced the importance of maintaining relationships
 - Eastern Shore Seaside Waterman and Shellfish Growers, Community Leadership and Landowners outreach
- Liaison Officer position should be staffed by a person familiar with and trusted by the community
 - Consider using local, county, or state personnel to fill role; ensure they are trained for the position

Lessons Learned - Best Practice

- Hampton Roads Volunteer
 - Update Annex to include use of website/virtual welcome center.
- Hampton Roads Incident Management Team Support for ICP
 - Ideal for rapid establishment and support of the Incident Command Post Facilities
- Good Staging Area
 - VIMS Boat Ramp was of ample size for staging area and also had a large secondary lot for overflow vehicles and trailers
 - Recommendation that this site be added to the Geographic Response Plan. Note that wind from SSW and/or low tide the low water will limit vessel size to shallow water boats
 - Eastern Shore Community college: Great footprint, located near center of the Virginia Eastern Shore

Areas for Improvement

- Develop a process to transfer management of an incident from the Command Center to the Sector Incident Management Team (IMT)
 - Recommendations Develop a process to transfer command; document process
- Waste Management Plan
 - Recommend that the draft waste management plan be included in the ACP
 - Draft can be updated/tailored for an incident occurring within Virginia
- Health Official Engagement for public safety
 - Leverage state/local Emergency Management and Public Affairs resources for proper notification and engagement

Areas for Improvement

- ► Eastern Shore Annex (ESA) to the Virginia ACP Familiarity and Access
 - Conduct ACP and Eastern Shore Annex familiarity training
- Booming Strategy Updates
 - Update GRS strategies
 - Limitation based on available sea going boom (Barge or Truck)
 - Funding for GRS validation
- Communication Stash
 - Work with state/local/federal agencies to see what communication resources they can provide; include information in the ACP
 - Add Verizon Response Team Capabilities and information to ACP
