LAW 171



➢Known as Reorganization Plan of the Department of Natural and Environmental Resources of 2018 (August 2, 2018).

- Amend Law 416, as amended, known as "Environmental Public Policy Act", which creates the Environmental Quality Board.
- ➢Transfer the "Environmental Research Laboratory of Puerto Rico" to the DNER
- ➢Assign funds from special accounts of the EQB to the corresponding special accounts that the DNER will create,
- ➢ Provide for transfers of employees and goods





LAW 171(cont.)

- ➢Transfers, groups and consolidates in the DNER, faculties, functions, services and structures of the EQB
- ➢The powers and functions previously delegated to the EQB, its President and / or its Governing Board are transferred to the DNER for execution by the Secretary
- DNER will establish a program for the response and adequate management of environmental emergencies and the necessary remedial actions in contaminated places
- DNER will be the leading agency in the responses to this type of emergencies


















EQB Regions

Environmental Emergencies

➢Establish that DNER is the leading agency to coordinate and implementing response measures when responding to environmental emergencies incidents.

➢All matters concerning environmental emergency response planning shall be responsibility of the Commonwealth Environmental Emergency Response Planning Commission (PRSERC), which is attached to DNER.


≻Create the Environmental Emergency Fund.

➢ Recovery of Expenses – DNER may recover 3 times the total amount incurred to the responsible party.
