Tall Ships 2019 ICS Exercise


- Two day exercise, March 8th and 9th (Simulated dates of July 5th and 6th).
- Involved both Active duty and Reservist personnel.
- Used both T-Cards and IMSS Online Application.
- Exercise Days:
 - ✤ March 8th (July 5th):


Stood up Incident Command Post in the Sector Buffalo community room, assigned positions per WQSB, and developed plan for the next operational period.

✤ March 9th (July 6th):

Relieved personnel and assumed assigned roles, conducted operations per plan from previous day, developed the plan for next operational period, and began demobilization.







Debrief of Tall Ships 2019 ICS Exercise

- ICS exercise incident was not preloaded or pre briefed to individuals involved except for DRAT. Involved members assumed the incident would be a pollution spill; turned out to be multiple explosions from terrorist attack.
- Required participants to think outside the box; re-evaluate expectations.
- Generated excellent table-top discussions regarding large-scale response and impacts to response efforts and staging areas.
- Exercise used for local training and to facilitate ICS qualifications.

 - 3. Radiation Nuclear Detection table top exercise in Alexandria Bay, NY.




Lake Ontario High Water
