SUBJECT: Region 8 Predesignated On Scene Coordinators

TO: Region 8 Emergency Response and Preparedness Program file

The National Contingency Plan (NCP), at 40 C.F.R. § 300.5, defines the On Scene Coordinator (OSC) as the federal official predesignated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency or the U.S. Coast Guard to coordinate and direct responses under the NCP Subpart D (related to discharges of oil to waters of the U.S.) or the government official designated by the lead agency to coordinate and direct removal actions under the NCP Subpart E (related to releases of hazardous substances or pollutants/contaminants). This memorandum shall serve to document the predesignated OSCs in Region 8, in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 300.120(a). The EPA OSC job has a specific, unique position description that defines the duties, responsibilities and expectations of the OSCs.
