

## **Hurricane Season 23:**



#### Lessons Learned:

- Need the plain-language definitions for state and county EOC operating and activation status.
- Compose/maintain an active duty, reserve, and civilian IMT assignment list for Type-3 Events/Incidents.

#### **Best Practices:**

- Ensure PORT CONDITION status changes are officially received <u>and acknowledged</u> by all state and county EOCs prior to the Storm.
- Establish a briefing battle rhythm early; share schedule, phone number(s), and passcode(s) with state and county EOCs via LNOs.
- Know physical location of USCG LNOs (assigned to state and county EOCs) at all times.

Unknown amount of mixed oils/hazmat

Cause of Spill: Business Fire

**Concerns:** Mixed oils discharged, and chemicals released into Huntington Harbor

Location of Spill: Shoreham, NY

Type and Amount of Product Spilled: 70 gallons of aviation fuel (potential)

Cause of Spill: Equipment Failure

**Other Agency Involvement:** 

NYSDEC, Suffolk PD, Suffolk Marine

Patrol

**Concerns:** Discharge of aviation fuel into the Long Island Sound























































### **Dredger SCROD II**



Date of Spill: 15 MAY 2023

Location of Spill: Bayshore, NY

**Type and Amount of Product** Spilled:

500 Gallons of bilge oil (potential)


Cause of Spill: Equipment


Failure
