## **Workgroup Report Outs & Feedback Session**

- CHER (John Nelson, DOI & Myles Bartos, US EPA)
  - NAGPRA
    - Executive committee will review draft and send out to larger RRT members for 30-day review.
    - When the document is approved, it will be incorporated into the RCP.
  - EU Quick reference guide
    - 99% complete, almost ready for final review.
    - Job aid tool of actionable objectives for EU leader to take on. Can also be utilized for members of EU.
  - o Unanticipated discovery plan
    - Assistance from Susan and Troy from Maryland SHPO
    - Pulling together an MOU/MOA, working with Maryland to identify actions that might trigger NHPA compliance.
      - If something happens this will direct who will be notified.
    - Maryland is very engaged. Plan to get a finished product with them to present to other states. Use as a tool to engage other states.
  - New business
    - 2026 Work Plan to include updates to notification procedures such as when trustee agencies should be notified of a spill. There is currently outdated information in the RCP.
- Spill Response Countermeasures (Dave Pugh, USCG / Billy Martin, US EPA)
  - o Future of dispersant MOU is being phased out.
  - Reaching out to other coastal regions about pre-authorization being phased out and how they are planning to proceed.
  - o Current MOU can be used as an outline for future "rapid consultation" procedure
- Training & Exercise (Sabina Bastias, US EPA / Kelly Thorkilson, USCG)
  - Workgroup went over functional exercise taking place tomorrow.
  - Discussed notification drill targeting standing RRT end of October or beginning of November.
  - Initiatives for in between meetings
    - Preparation for spring tabletop drill, concepts and objective meetings with executive committee to kick off exercise plan to pick which part of plan to focus on
- RCP Workgroup (Kevin Gaynor, US EPA / Kelly Thorkilson, USCG)
  - Plan to approve and sign RCP.
  - Mike asks about pre-authorization
    - Stands as being in place with Zone A removed. Need a letter from Delaware confirming this to attach.
  - Working on setting up procedures for revisions of main body and appendices and will hopefully have this process set up by December.
  - Plans to track down reserve appendices.

- Information Management and Outreach (Brian Moore, PADEP)
  - Finished up website
  - O Shifting workgroup focus to data analytics, nomenclature and backend work.
    - Initiative to use common language across different agencies.
  - Sabina asks if everyone can access RRT website effectively since part of the Work Plan objectives for this workgroup is to do training on website.
    - John hasn't explored a place to put documents. Possible discussion of website tools.
    - RRT members need to spend more time on the website to familiarize themselves.
      - Tentatively put together a page for navigation.
