

**Type and Amount of Product** Spilled:


500 Gallons of bilge oil (potential)


Cause of Spill: Equipment

Location of Incident: Oceanside, NY


Type and Amount of Product:

#### **Public Outreach**




Date of Event: 12 OCT 2023
