  - State Fire Marshal if responders need additional hazmat technical expertise.
- North Dakota Oil & Gas Division if the incident involves crude oil, natural gas or saltwater/brine spill/release.
  - Local/Tribal Emergency Manager
- North Dakota Game & Fish if waterways/wetlands are threatened or impacted.
  - U.S. Fish & Wildlife if waterways/wetlands are threatened or impacted.
  - North Dakota Department of Agriculture if pesticides are involved.
- North Dakota Public Service Commission (PSC) if incident involves a release or explosion of natural gas, fuel, crude oil or propane from a distribution line.
- Occupational Safety and Health Administration is notified if there is private sector employment-related injury, illness or death.

### Level II:

1. Hazardous materials spill/release requires outside assistance.
2. Local government response necessary.
3. Notification necessary to the NRC, SERC and LEPC.

### Level III:

1. Hazardous materials spill/release requires outside assistance.
2. Local and county government response necessary.
3. Notification necessary to the NRC, SERC, and LEPC.

### Level IV:

1. Hazardous materials spill/release requires outside large scale assistance.
2. State and/or federal response necessary.
3. Notification necessary to the NRC, SERC, and LEPC.

## INTERNAL STATE PROTOCOL FOR REPORTING OF SPILLS

Oil or hazardous substances releases that enter, or threaten to enter, waters of the state shall be immediately reported by the responsible person, firm, or corporation to the Wyoming Water Quality Division and Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality. The Wyoming Water Quality Division will provide appropriate notification to other state, county, or local agencies/officials. The Wyoming Water Quality Division will also notify the responsible oil and hazardous substance response agency of a neighboring state when a release threatens to enter their waters. Personnel of the Wyoming Game and Fish Department will be asked to respond to releases that have the potential to reach or have already reached surface waters. The Game and Fish Department personnel will oversee the initial response force, and their recommendations as to probable or actual environmental impact may determine further action by the division.

When Wyoming Highway Patrol personnel are alerted to a release along a highway, roadway, etc., within their particular jurisdiction, the Wyoming Highway Patrol immediately report the incident to the division and provide assistance as needed at the scene.
